Post - Discussion Questions

ask after lesson

- 2. What counterfeit are you chasing?
- 3. How do you feel God is pursuing you?
- 4. Have you ever felt that you were beyond redemption? How does the narrative of the Bible give you hope?
- 5. God pursues His people even and especially when they fail; how does this truth affect you?
- 6. What practices to engage with the story of Scripture do you want to integrate?
